
“And They Glorified God in Me” – Galatians 1:13-24

Introduction: Paul’s Credentials

I. *“Paul, an apostle”*- vs. 1

- A. The argument could be made that Paul was not a legitimate apostle.
- B. The gospel Paul preached *“came through the revelation of Jesus Christ”* (verse 12b).
 - 1. This revelation began on a road to Damascus when he met Jesus (Acts 9:1-16).
 - 2. This revelation of Jesus Christ did not end at the road to Damascus.

Paul’s first credential in discerning between the true gospel and a false gospel was his apostleship. He had been taught by Jesus, not the traditions of men.

II. Paul’s personal testimony – vs. 13-22

- A. Paul, the believer in the good works gospel – vs. 13-14
- B. Paul, the believer in the gospel of Christ alone – vs. 15.
- C. Paul, the spokesman of the gospel of Christ – vs. 16a
- D. Paul’s preparation for declaring the gospel of Christ – vs. 16b-21
- E. Paul, the sanctified believer in the gospel of Christ – vs. 22-24

Paul’s testimony reveals the truth of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

III. *“And they glorified God in me”*-vs. 24

Conclusion: The goal of every Christian should be what is stated by Paul. They saw a change in my life, *“and they glorified God in me.”*
